#### **MINISTER'S MESSAGE**

Aloha, Members and Friends of Taishoji,

Happy New Year! Akemashite Omedeto Gozaimasu! Hau'oli Makahiki Hou!



Thank you very much for your generous kind support last year. Thanks to everyone, 2017 was both full and fulfilling. We had the garage sale, lay confirmation ceremony, Zen food class, calligraphy performance and so on. Through these activities, we had great experiences and a wonderful encounter. In 2018, how do you want to spend your time? Whatever you do, I recommend you to do zazen before you do what you want. In November, Japanese calligraphy teacher, **Mr. Koki Takehara** came to Taishoji and gave a live performance. I made a request to him to draw Zen words for our Zazen Session and for our Jodo-e Service. The words are called "非思量 (**Hishiryo**)" which means non-thinking or beyond thinking. It is one of the most important words used to describe zazen and it's concepts. I will display his work on the wall in the main hall from December 1<sup>st</sup> as encouragement and



inspiration for Zazen. "Hishiryo" means non-thinking, but it is not to be in a state of daydreaming without thinking. It is just doing what we do now. According to the research of neurologists in the US, human beings think about 15 thousand to 50 thousand things a day. They say 80% of this thought is about fear. We are usually thinking about a lot of things and feel fear. That's why, Soto Zen Buddhist try to do Zazen. By adjusting our posture and harmonizing our breath, our mind will naturally calm down and this will help you to act with compassion to others. Even 5 minutes or 10 minutes a day is OK. Please set aside time that you will sit and calm your mind. Zazen is a precious Buddhist practice that we should cherish. Finally, I'd like to spend as much time with you and for us to support each other from now on. May this New Year bring happiness and joy for you and your family.
